During the first two decades of the nineteenth century, two of the most significant theoretical works on color since Leonardo da Vinci's *Trattato della Pittura* were written and published in Germany: Arthur Schopenhauer's *On Vision and Colors* and Philipp Otto Runge's *Color Sphere*. By bringing these two visionary color theories together within a broad theoretical context—philosophy, art,

architecture, and design—this volume uncovers their enduring influence on our own perception of color and the visual world around us.
