Octave Mirbeau (1848-1917) was a French journalist, art critic, pamphleteer, novelist, and playwright, who achieved celebrity in Europe and great success among the public, while still appealing to the literary and artistic avant-garde. His work has been translated into thirty languages. After authoring ten ghostwritten novels, he made his own literary debut with *Le Calvaire* (Calvary,

1886), in which writing allowed him to overcome the traumatic effects of his devastating liaison with the ill-reputed Judith Vimmer, renamed Juliette Roux in the novel. In 1888, He published *L Abb Jules* (Abb Jules), the first pre-Freudian novel written under the influence of Dostoyevsky to appear in French literature; the text featured two main interesting characters: *L abb Jules* and *Father Pamphile*. In *Sbastien Roch* (1890), Mirbeau purged the traumatic effects of his experience as a student during his sojourn among the Jesuits of Vannes. His other works include: *Dans le Ciel* (1893) (In the Sky), *Le Jardin des Supplices* (1899) (Torture Garden) and *Le Journal d une Femme de Chambre* (1900) (A Chambermaid s Diary).
