Darby, the founder of Dispensationalism, and among his many successors are Hal Lindsay, and the *Left Behind* books. Unlike

more recent authors, however, Larkin does not make any claims to know when or exactly how the prophecies will unfold. Rather he takes us on a grand tour of the Apocalypse of St. John, and guides us through its images, symbols and poetry. Larkin sorts out what could be a reference to an actual event or person, (without attempting any particular association) and what is pure symbolism.
