Muntaner, a qui Josep Pla va definir com «un empordanès xerraire i mentider», s'agrada de recontar les seves històries, i ho fa amb una prosa àgil i vivaç, farcida de dites i expressions populars, però que beu igualment de les fórmules i els motius presents en les cançons de gesta i els romans d'aventures. El treball que hom té a les mans presenta una edició filològica del pròleg i els primers cent quaranta-sis capítols del text muntanerian, que comprenen els regnats de Jaume I el Conqueridor i Pere II el Gran i fan poc més o menys la meitat de tota la Crònica. L'edició, que incorpora un aparat ben copiós de notes de tipus històric, cultural, lingüístic i estilístic, a

més de nombroses imatges procedents de manuscrits medievals i fotografies de llocs, edificis i objectes esmentats per Muntaner, s'acompanya, encara, d'un estudi introductori que analitza algunes de les claus literàries i historiogràfiques dels capítols esmentats.
