La sociedad actual se desarrolla en torno a unas demandas visuales cada vez mayores. En las actividades escolares, un 90% de la información que se recibe es visual, llegando hasta un 100% en las tareas de lectura. Según recientes estudios, el porcentaje de fracaso escolar es cada vez más elevado. En la población infantil, los problemas de aprendizaje alcanzan valores del 11%, siendo un 80% debido a problemas de procesamiento visual y un 60% a
