Basic Lessons on Life Living Stream Ministry

The Collected Works of Witness Lee, 1969, volume 3, contains messages given by Brother Witness Lee from July 17 through December 28, 1969. Brother Lee remained in Los Angeles through the month of July until the end of August. He made a brief trip to San Francisco, California, and then rested nearly the entire month of September. At the beginning of October he visited San Francisco, California; and then traveled to Phoenix, Arizona; Mesa, Arizona; Albuquerque, New Mexico; Las Vegas, Nevada; and San Francisco, California; a second time. After returning to Los Angeles for one day in the middle of November, he visited Yorba Linda, California; Louisville, Kentucky; Toronto, Canada; East Hartland, Connecticut; Boston, Massachusetts; New York City; Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania; and Erie, Pennsylvania. He returned to Los Angeles at the end of December. Regrettably, there is no record of his speaking in Phoenix, Las Vegas, Louisville, Toronto, East Hartland, and Boston. The majority of his speaking in Pittsburgh and Erie was recorded in handwritten notes. The contents of this volume are divided into fourteen sections, as follows: 1. Twenty-six messages given in Los Angeles, California, from July 17 through August 21. These messages were previously published in a twenty-four-chapter book under the title *Christ and the Church Revealed and Typified in the Psalms*. 2. One message given in Los Angeles, California, on August 16. It is included in this volume under the title *An Additional Word in Response to Testimonies concerning Five Secrets of Life Revealed in Second Peter 1*. 3. Five messages given in Los Angeles, California, on August 22 through 24. The first four of these messages were previously published in *The Ministry* magazine, volume 2, numbers 4 through 7, April, May, June, and July 1998, and the fifth message was previously published in *The Ministry* magazine, volume 2, number 8, August/September 1998, as one section of a compilation of Brother Lee's speaking on migration during the years 1969, 1970, 1971, and 1972. The entire series of five messages previously published in *The Ministry* magazine appeared under the title *Migration in God's Move*. 4. One message given in Los Angeles, California, on November 16. This message is included in this section under the title *Fellowship on Migration*. 5. Seven messages given in San Francisco, California, from August 29 through September 1 and on October 3. They are included in this volume under the title *Exercising the Spirit and Walking according to the Spirit to Build Up the Church*. 6. Three messages given in Los Angeles, California, on August 21 and 22. They are included in this volume under the title *Denying Our Soul-life and the Living, Walking, and Abiding in Our Spirit for the Building Up of the Church*. 7. One message given in Los Angeles, California, on September 25. This message is included in this volume under the title *Helping the New Believers to Be Properly Grounded in Their Salvation and to Grow in Life*. 8. One message given in Mesa, Arizona, on October 15. It is included in this volume under the title *Needing to Live in Our Spirit in Order to Meet in the Proper Way*. 9. Six messages given in Albuquerque, New Mexico, on October 17 through 20. These messages are published in this volume under the title *Enjoying the All-inclusive Spirit in Our Human Spirit for the Building Up of the Church*. There is no record of the first two messages. 10. Four messages given in San Francisco, California, on November 7 through 9. They are included in this volume under the title *Fall Conference in San Francisco*. 11. Eight messages given in Yorba Linda, California, on November 27 through 30. These messages are included in this volume under the title *The Two Trees in the Christian Life*. Two of the messages were combined. 12. Four messages given in New York City on December 18 through 21. They are included in this volume under the title *Enjoying and Ministering Christ for the Fulfillment of God's Purpose*. 13. One message given in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, on December 22. This message is included in this volume under the title *The Lord's Recovery of the Practice of the Church Life*. Its contents were taken from the personal notes of an attendee. Brother Lee spoke two additional messages on December 23, but there is no substantial record of his

speaking. 14. Thirteen messages given in Erie, Pennsylvania, on December 24 through 28. These messages are included in this volume under the title *The Lord's Recovery of the Church Life*. Of the thirteen messages spoken, only two were recorded. The content of the remaining chapters was taken from the personal notes of a conference attendee. Some messages were combined to form the nine chapters in this section. In addition to the above, Brother Lee gave six messages in Los Angeles, California, on August 16 through 21. These messages, together with messages given in 1963 and 1965, were previously published in a book under the title *Our Human Spirit*. This book in its entirety is included in *The Collected Works of Witness Lee, 1965, volume 3*.

Life-Study of Revelation Living Stream Ministry

In the Lord's recovery during the past five hundred years the church's knowledge of the Lord and His truth has been continually progressing. This monumental and classical work by Brother Witness Lee builds upon and is a further development of all that the Lord has revealed to His church in the past centuries. It is filled with the revelation concerning the processed Triune God, the living Christ, the life-giving Spirit, the experience of life, and the definition and practice of the church. In this set Brother Lee has kept three basic principles that should rule and govern every believer in their interpretation, development, and expounding of the truths contained in the Scriptures. The first principle is that of the Triune God dispensing Himself into His chosen and redeemed people; the second principle is that we should interpret, develop, and expound the truths contained in the Bible with Christ for the church; and the third governing principle is Christ, the Spirit, life, and the church. No other study or exposition of the New Testament conveys the life nourishment or ushers the reader into the divine revelation of God's holy Word according to His New Testament economy as this one does.

The Collected Works of Witness Lee, 1956, volume 3 Living Stream Ministry

In the book of Ephesians, the church is revealed as the assembly, the household, the Body of Christ, and the new man. The church as the Body of Christ needs Christ as its life, whereas the Church as the new man, the highest aspect of the church, needs Christ as its person. According to Colossians 3:10-11, Christ is all and in all in the new man; thus, in the new man, there is no room for natural persons, culture, status, or ethics. In the new man there is only one person—Christ.

The Collected Works of Witness Lee, 1963, volume 4, contains the messages and fellowship given by Brother Witness Lee from September 4 through December 31, 1963. In the first part of September Brother Lee spent a few days ministering to the saints in Las Vegas, Nevada. There are indications that he also passed through Albuquerque, New Mexico, for a few days afterward; however, there is no record of his speaking during that time. On the weekend of September 20 and 21 he ministered to the saints in Tyler, Texas, and toward the end of the month he traveled to New York City, where he ministered for more than two weeks. In the month of November Brother Lee returned to Texas for a week to release messages in Tyler and Dallas. The following weekend he stopped briefly in Los Angeles and then traveled up the West Coast to Sacramento and San Francisco, California, giving weeklong conferences in both cities. In December Brother Lee again returned to Los Angeles, where he ministered until the end of the year, sometimes speaking two or three times a day. The contents of this volume are divided into twelve sections, as follows: 1. Four messages given in Las Vegas on September 4 through 7. These messages were published under the title *Contacting the Lord, Being Filled in Spirit, and Having Proper Christian Meetings for the Accomplishment of God's Eternal Purpose*. There are indications, but no solid evidence, that the last message was given in Albuquerque, New Mexico. 2. Three messages given at a conference in Tyler on September 20 and 21. These messages are included in this volume under the title *Experiencing Christ as Life for Our Transformation into His Image*. Records indicate that originally four messages were given, but the last two, which were given on the same day and at the same location, were combined into one message. 3. Four messages given at a conference in New York City from September 29 through

October 6. These messages are included in this volume under the title *The Practical Way to Fulfill God's Eternal Purpose*. 4. Four messages given at a conference in New York City on October 11 through 13. These messages were published under the title *The Exercise of Our Spirit for the Release of the Spirit*. 5. A series of twelve messages given in the Tyler and Dallas area on November 7 through 15. These messages are included in this volume under the title *Being Transformed for the Practice of the Church Life*. 6. Three messages given in Tyler at various times during the month of November. These messages are included in this volume under the title *The Fulfillment of God's Purpose and the Defeat of God's Enemy*. 7. Six messages given at a conference in Sacramento on November 22 through 25. These messages were published under the title *Experiencing Christ as the Inner Life*. 8. Eleven messages given in San Francisco from November 28 through December 1. These messages were published under the title *The Relationship of God with Man in God's New Creation*. 9. Messages given on two Lord's Days, November 17 and December 15, in Los Angeles. These messages are included in this volume under the title *Lord's Day Messages in Los Angeles*. The second message was divided into two parts. 10. Three messages constructed from personal notes of Brother Lee's fellowship with the leading ones on December 14 and 20 in Los Angeles. These messages are included in this volume under the title *Fellowship with the Leading Ones*. 11. Sixteen messages given at a conference in Los Angeles on December 22 through 31. These messages were published under the title *The Life and Way for the Practice of the Church Life*. 12. One message given at a meeting in Los Angeles on December 28. This message is included in this volume under the section title *Fellowship concerning the Body of Christ*. There are indications that this message was one in a series of informal talks that Brother Lee gave during the conference held on December 22 through 31. Records of the other talks were not available for publication.

The Collected Works of Witness Lee, 1950-1951, volume 1 Living Stream Ministry

To prophesy in the sense of 1 Corinthians 14 denotes to speak for God and Christ and to speak forth God and Christ. To speak forth God and Christ is to minister and dispense God and Christ to people. This book helps us to see the basic knowledge concerning prophesying, the patterns of prophesy, the basic constituents of a prophecy, and the obstacles to prophesying.

Watchman Nee Living Stream Ministry

The Collected Works of Witness Lee, 1959, volume 3, contains messages given by Brother Witness Lee in September through December 1959. Historical information concerning Brother Lee's travels and the content of his ministry in 1959 can be found in the general preface that appears at the beginning of volume 1 in this set. The contents of this volume are divided into four sections, as follows: 1. Personal notes consisting of two sets of outlines for gospel meetings held in Taipei and Kaohsiung, Taiwan, in September and November 1959. These notes are included in this volume under the title *Witness Lee's Personal Notes*. 2. Twenty-five messages given in Taipei, Taiwan, in the fall of 1959. These messages were previously published in a book entitled *Lessons for New Believers* and are included in this volume under the same title. 3. Five messages given in Taipei, Taiwan, in the first part of a training that began on October 5, 1959, and concluded on January 22, 1960. Chapters 1, 2, 4, and 5 were previously published in a book entitled *On Knowing the Bible*. Chapter 3 was added based on notes taken by Brother K. H. Weigh and his wife, Lin Yi-tian. The messages that compose the first four chapters were given on October 6 through 9, 1959, and the fifth message was probably given shortly thereafter. The five messages are included in this volume under the same title as the previously published book. 4. Ten messages given in Taipei, Taiwan, in the second part of a training that began on October 5, 1959, and concluded on January 22, 1960. These messages were previously published in a book entitled *Ten Lines in the Bible*. Later, two appendices were added based on notes taken by Brother K. H. Weigh and his wife, Lin Yi-tian. The exact dates for the speaking of these messages are unknown, but they were given in the winter of 1959. The ten messages and the two appendices are included in this volume under the same title as the previously published book.

Christ as the Reality Living Stream Ministry

The Collected Works of Witness Lee, 1956, volume 3, contains messages given by Brother Witness Lee from May 2, 1956, through January 21, 1957. Historical information concerning Brother Lee's travels and the content of his ministry in 1956 can be found in the general preface that appears at the beginning of volume 1 in this set. The contents of this volume are divided into eleven sections, as follows: 1. Two messages given in Taipei, Taiwan, on May 2 and 3, 1956. These messages are included in this volume under the title *Comments on the Testimonies of the Trainees*. 2. Two messages published in *The Ministry of the Word* in 1956. These messages are included in this volume under the title *A God Who Hides Himself*. Chapter 1 of this section is an unabridged version of the message included in volume 2 as chapter 1 of the section entitled *The Ministry of the Word, Miscellaneous Messages, 1956*. 3. Two sets of personal notes written in July 1956 and in October through December 1956. These notes are included in this volume under the title *Witness Lee's Personal Notes*. 4. A talk given in Hong Kong on August 15, 1956. This talk is included in this volume under the title *A Talk concerning Wedding Meetings*. 5. Eight messages given in Hong Kong on August 21 through 30, 1956. These messages are included in this volume under the title *The Inner Operation of God and the Salvation of Man's Tripartite Being*. 6. Nine messages given in Hong Kong on August 22 through 30, 1956. These messages are included in this volume under the title *Transformation and Conformation in God's Salvation*. 7. Five messages given in Hong Kong beginning on September 2, 1956. These messages, which appear as four chapters and an appendix, were previously published in a book entitled *The Meaning and Purpose of Prayer* and are included in this volume under the same title. 8. Fourteen messages given in Hong Kong on September 5 through October 4, 1956. These messages are included in this volume under the title *Guidelines for the Experience of Life*. 9. Ten messages given in Hong Kong in September and October 1956. These messages are included in this volume under the title *Guidelines for Service*. 10. Ten messages given in Hong Kong in September and October 1956. These messages are included in this volume under the title *Critiques Given during the Practice of Giving Messages*. 11. Six messages given in Manila, Philippines, on December 31, 1956, through January 21, 1957. These messages are included in this volume under the title *The Testimony of Jesus and Our Overcoming*.

The One New Man Living Stream Ministry

The contents of this volume are divided into five sections, as follows: 1. Seventeen letters written from August 27, 1932, through July 15, 1935. These letters were published in the periodical *Collection of Newsletters* in November 1933 through July 1935 and are included in this volume under the same title. 2. Three articles written from July through September 1934. These articles were published in the periodical *The Glad Tidings* and are included in this volume under the title *The Glad Tidings, 1934*. 3. Thirty-two articles and reports published in the periodical *The Christian* from 1934 through 1940. These articles are included in this volume under the same title. 4. A message given in an unknown location in 1936. This message is included in this volume under the title *Concerning the Human Living of the Believers*. 5. Twelve letters written from December 9, 1937, through June 5, 1939. These letters were published in the periodical *The Open Door* in January 1938 through June 5, 1939, and are included in this volume under the same title.

The Practice of Prophesying Living Stream Ministry

When God created man, He placed him before two trees: the tree of the knowledge of good and evil and the tree of life. In warning man to avoid the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, God

indicated His desire for man to eat of the tree of life, signifying that man should receive God as his life supply. Witness Lee unveils in the *The Tree of Life* that God is not looking for well-behaved Christians; He is looking for those who will experience and enjoy Christ as the reality of the tree of life.

Life Lessons, 2 Living Stream Ministry

The Collected Works of Witness Lee, 1966, volume 1, contains messages and fellowship given by Brother Witness Lee from January through August 1966. For the first three months of the year, Brother Lee remained in Los Angeles, except for a brief visit to San Francisco in late February. From the end of March through the middle of April, he visited Mineral Wells, Waco, Tyler, and Plainview, Texas. From Texas he proceeded to Albuquerque, New Mexico, and then he returned to San Francisco at the end of April. He spent the month of May in Los Angeles. From mid-June to mid-July he visited a number of cities in the Midwest, including Indianapolis, Indiana; Mansfield and Warren, Ohio; East Peoria, Illinois; and Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. The only record of his visit to these cities consists of four messages given in Warren, Ohio. In the middle of July, Brother Lee returned to Los Angeles and remained there through the end of September. The contents of this volume are divided into twelve sections, as follows: 1. Eight messages given in Los Angeles, California, from January 30 through March 20. These messages are included in this volume under the title *Miscellaneous Lord's Day Meetings in Los Angeles*. 2. Four messages given in Los Angeles, California, from February 4 through March 18. These messages are included in this volume under the title *Messages on Matthew*. 3. Four messages given in Los Angeles, California, from February 17 through 20. These messages have been previously published under the title *Christ Our Portion*. 4. Four messages given in San Francisco, California, on February 22 through 25. These messages are included in this volume under the title *The Lord's Recovery of the Church*. 5. Five messages given in San Francisco, California, from April 29 through May 1. These messages are included in this volume under the title *Enjoying Christ as Our Feast to Be His Fruit-bearing Branches*. 6. One message given in Tyler, Texas, on April 10. This message is published in this volume under the title *Exercising Our Spirit in Our Daily Life for the Meeting Life*. 7. Four messages given in Plainview, Texas, on April 15 through 18. They were previously published in *The Stream*, volume 4, number 4, November 1966, under the title *God's High Calling*. 8. Seven messages given in Los Angeles, California, on May 10 through 31. These messages are included in this volume under the title *Fellowship on Life, Building, and Fruit-bearing*. The last two messages were combined into one chapter. 9. Five messages given in Los Angeles, California, from May 13 through 28. These messages are published in this volume under the title *Miscellaneous Messages in Los Angeles*. 10. Six messages given in Los Angeles, California, from May 8 through July 17. They are included in this volume under the title *Various Lord's Day Meetings in Los Angeles*. 11. Four messages given in Warren, Ohio, on June 24 and 25. These messages are included in this section under the title *Conference in Warren, Ohio*. 12. Eighteen messages given in Los Angeles, California, from July 24 through August 28. These messages have been previously published under the title *The Priesthood*.

Character Living Stream Ministry

The Collected Works of Witness Lee, 1964, volume 3, contains messages and fellowship given by Brother Witness Lee from August 11 through December 10, 1964. During this period Brother Lee spent the majority of his time in Los Angeles, aside from a weekend trip to Tyler, Texas, in September, a weeklong trip in December to Seattle, Washington, and Portland, Eugene, and North Bend, Oregon, and a weekend to visit the saints in Las Vegas, Nevada. No record of his speaking on these trips has been found. The contents of this volume are divided into eight sections, as follows: 1. A series of five messages given on August 11 through 19 during the summer training in Los Angeles. These messages are included in this volume under the title *Basic Principles for the Church Meetings*. 2. A series of twelve messages given on August 18 through 30 during the summer training in Los Angeles. This series is included in this volume under the title *The Oneness of the Body and the Service in the Church Life*. 3. Messages given in Los Angeles on August 4 through 6 and September 13. Brother Lee gave four messages, which have been condensed into the three chapters of this section, entitled *Prayer in Ephesians*. 4. A series of twenty-four messages given from August 4 through September 2 during the summer training in Los Angeles. This series has been previously published under the title *The Economy of God*. 5. Three messages given in Los Angeles on August 2 and 3. These messages are included in this volume under the title *Various Meetings in Los Angeles*. 6. Miscellaneous messages given in Los Angeles on August 12 through 29. These messages are included in this volume under the title *Miscellaneous Fellowship in Los Angeles*. 7. A series of five messages given in Los Angeles on September 7 through 9. These messages are included in this volume under the title *Fellowship concerning Migration*. 8. Twelve messages given in various meetings in Los Angeles from September 15 through December 10. These messages are included in this volume under the title *Various Fall Meetings in Los Angeles*.

Concerning the Person of Christ Living Stream Ministry

The Collected Works of Witness Lee, 1961-1962, volume 4, contains messages given by Brother Witness Lee on August 13, 1962, through January 24, 1963. Historical information concerning Brother Lee's travels and the content of his ministry in 1961 and 1962 can be found in the general preface that appears at the beginning of volume 1 in this set. The contents of this volume are divided into seven sections, as follows: 1. Eleven messages given in Los Angeles, California, on August 13 through September 3, 1962. These messages are included in this volume under the title *Experiencing Christ in a Practical Way for the Building Up of the Church*. 2. Five messages given in San Francisco, California, on November 21 through 25, 1962. These messages are included in this volume under the title *Recovering the First Love and Seeing the Vision of Christ and the Church*. 3. Nine messages given in Los Angeles. The first seven messages were given on December 4 through 11, 1962, and the remaining two messages were given on January 22 and 24, 1963. These messages were previously published in a book entitled *The Mystery of God and the Mystery of Christ* and are included in this volume under the same title. 4. Sixteen messages given in Los Angeles on December 22 through 31, 1962. These messages were previously published in a book entitled *The All-inclusive Christ* and are included in this volume under the same title. 5. Nine messages given in Los Angeles on December 24 through 31, 1962. These messages are included in this volume under the title *The Lord's Recovery of the Expression of Christ by the Power of Resurrection and through the Overcoming Believers*. 6. Eight messages given during a conference in Los Angeles that began on December 22, 1962. These messages are included in this volume under the title *The Knowledge and Experience of Christ in Ephesians and Colossians*. 7. A message given during a time of fellowship in Los Angeles on December 31, 1962. This message is included in this volume under the title *Fellowship concerning the First Day of the First Month of the Year*.

The Collected Works of Witness Lee, 1953, volume 2 Living Stream Ministry

As we are learning to serve the Lord, we need to be in constant fellowship with Him and rely on His grace, but we also must be willing to address the matter of our character in order to be useful to the Master. The things which can be entrusted to us, the responsibilities we can bear, and the things we can accomplish are fully dependent on our character. In *Character* Witness Lee addresses the crucial matter of developing a proper character in those who love and serve the Lord. Beginning with a brief description of thirty essential character traits, Witness Lee provides a clear understanding of the importance of character and then presents clear examples of proper character from the Bible.

Finally, he shows the relationship between our character and our capacity to effectively contact people in order to bring them into contact with the Lord. Ultimately, our effectiveness in reaching people for the Lord depends on our character.

It is rather difficult for any Christian to grow without attending the meetings. There is no way for any Christian to serve God without meetings, and it is impossible for Christians to express Christ if there are no meetings. The church life is a meeting life.” In *How to Meet Witness Lee* offers much precious and practical guidance related to the biblical way to meet as Christians.

God's Way in Life Living Stream Ministry

The *Collected Works of Witness Lee, 1968, volume 1*, contains messages given by Brother Witness Lee from January through early August 1968. Brother Lee remained in Los Angeles until the end of January, after which he visited Dallas, Texas; Birmingham, Alabama; and Orlando and Miami, Florida, on his way to Sao Paulo, Brazil. He returned to Los Angeles in late February. There is no record of his speaking in the cities outside Los Angeles. In the middle of March Brother Lee traveled to the eastern part of the United States, visiting Lubbock, Texas; Greensboro and High Point, North Carolina; Birmingham, Alabama; New York City and Buffalo, New York; Toronto, Canada; Minneapolis, Minnesota; Mansfield and Cleveland, Ohio; Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania; and Indianapolis, Indiana, before returning to Los Angeles in the middle of May. During this same trip he might also have visited Boston, Massachusetts; Montreal and Ottawa, Canada; and Louisville, Kentucky. The only record of Brother Lee's speaking on this trip was in High Point and New York City. At the end of May Brother Lee visited Dinuba, California, for two days and returned to spend the next week in Los Angeles. In the middle of June he traveled to Las Vegas, Nevada; San Francisco, California; and Corvallis, Oregon, before returning to Los Angeles, where he remained until the end of July. There is no record of his speaking in Las Vegas or Corvallis. From late July through the middle of November Brother Lee visited the Far East. From July 25 through August 22 he was in Taiwan, where he was joined by over one hundred forty brothers and sisters from the United States and Canada, along with some saints from Brazil, Japan, Korea, Malaysia, Singapore, Indonesia, Hong Kong, Denmark, and West Germany. During those days he ministered in Taipei, Taichung, and Kaohsiung. The contents of this volume are divided into eight sections, as follows: 1. Twenty-three messages given in Los Angeles, California, from January 1 through July 7. These messages are included in this volume under the title *Various Messages in Los Angeles*. Two pairs of messages were combined. 2. One message given in High Point, North Carolina, on March 24. This message is included in this volume under the title *Message Given in High Point, North Carolina*. 3. Four messages given in New York City on March 30 and 31. They are included in this volume under the title *Various Meetings in New York*. 4. Four messages given in Dinuba, California, on May 29 and 30. These messages are included in this volume under the title *Knowing and Experiencing Christ as the Spirit by Exercising Our Spirit*. 5. Four messages given in San Francisco, California, from June 14 through 16. They are included in this volume under the title *Life Principles for the Proper Practice of the Church Life*. 6. Ten messages given in Los Angeles, California, on July 4 through 7. They are published in this volume under the title *Christ in the Stage of the Spirit in the New Testament*. 7. Twenty-four messages given in Los Angeles, California, on July 9 through 19. These messages were previously published as a twenty-two-chapter book under the title *The Practical Expression of the Church*. 8. Thirteen messages given in Taipei, Taichung, and Kaohsiung, Taiwan, from July 26 through August 3. The first ten messages, given in Taipei, were previously published as a standalone book in Chinese under the title *Turning the Age and Living in the Spirit*. These ten messages are included in this volume, together with the three messages given in Taichung and Kaohsiung, under the same title.

The Collected Works of Witness Lee, 1959, volume 3 Living Stream Ministry

The *Collected Works of Witness Lee, 1963, volume 1*, contains the messages and fellowship given by Brother Witness Lee from January 2 through March 31, 1963. Two additional messages included in this volume were given on December 4 and 13, 1962. Most of Brother Lee's time during the months of January and February was spent in the metropolitan area of Los Angeles. During this time he gave conferences in the Los Angeles area. His first trip outside the Los Angeles area in 1963 was to Sacramento, California, on February 25. After ministering there for several days, Brother Lee returned to Los Angeles for about a week. Beginning on March 8 he spoke in a conference in New York City on four consecutive weekends until the end of the month. The contents of this volume are divided into eleven sections, as follows: 1. Seven messages given in Whittier, California, on January 2 through 8. These messages have been published under the title *The Believer's Experience of Transformation*. 2. Thirteen messages given in Los Angeles and previously published under the title *Spiritual Applications of the Tabernacle*. Messages 1 and 2 were given on December 4 and 13, 1962, and the remainder of the messages were given over the period from January 12 through February 7, 1963. Messages 12 and 13 were combined to form the final chapter. 3. Two messages given in Los Angeles on January 15 and 17. These messages are included in this volume under the title *Prayer on the Ground of Christ's Ascension*. 4. Two messages given in Los Angeles on January 19. These messages have been combined and published under the title *The Divine Stream*. 5. A series of three messages given in Los Angeles on February 3 and 10. These messages are included in this volume under the title *The Key to Our Experience of Transformation--Knowing the Inward Parts of Man*. 6. Four messages given in Los Angeles on February 5 through 10. These messages are included in this volume under the title *Highlights from the Gospel of John*. The first two chapters were constructed from personal notes taken by brothers who were present in the meetings. 7. Six messages given during a conference in Reseda and Los Angeles, California, on February 12 through 17. These messages have been published under the title *The Practical Way to Live in the Mingling of God with Man*. No record exists for the third message. 8. Four messages given at a conference in Sacramento on February 25 through 28. These messages have been published under the title *The Enjoyment of*

Christ for His Increase. 9. Ten messages constructed from personal notes of talks that Brother Lee gave to the leading ones during the period from January 18 through March 3 in the greater Los Angeles area. These messages are included in this volume under the title *Various Times of Fellowship with the Leading Ones in Los Angeles*. 10. Twelve messages given during a conference in New York City on March 8 through 31. These messages have been published under the title *Experiencing the Mingling of God with Man for the Oneness of the Body of Christ*. 11. One message given in New York City in March; the exact date is uncertain. This message was spoken in Chinese and translated simultaneously into English. The English translation is the basis for the English edition, included in this volume under the title *The Two Spirits in the Gospel of John*.

Living Christ Living Stream Ministry

The *Collected Works of Witness Lee, 1953, volume 2*, contains messages given by Brother Witness Lee in September through December 1953. Historical information concerning Brother Lee's travels and the content of his ministry in 1953 can be found in the general preface that appears at the beginning of volume 1 in this set. The contents of this volume are divided into three sections, as follows: 1. Thirty-six messages given in Taipei, Taiwan, on September 1 through October 30, 1953. These messages are included in this volume under the title *Revelations in Ephesians: Seeing the Blessings and Position of the Church in Christ*. 2. Twenty-two messages given in Taipei, Taiwan, on November 3 through December 8, 1953. These messages are included in this volume under the title *Revelations in Ephesians: Seeing the Living and Responsibility of the Church in the Holy Spirit*. 3. A summary report, which appears in the preface of this section, followed by fourteen messages given in Taipei, Taiwan, from September through December 1953. The report and messages are included in this volume under the title *Messages and Fellowship Given during the Service Training in Taipei*.

The Collected Works of Witness Lee, 1963, volume 3 Living Stream Ministry

In the Lord's recovery during the past five hundred years the church's knowledge of the Lord and His truth has been continually progressing. This monumental and classical work by Brother Witness Lee builds upon and is a further development of all that the Lord has revealed to His church in the past centuries. It is filled with the revelation concerning the processed Triune God, the living Christ, the life-giving Spirit, the experience of life, and the definition and practice of the church. In this set Brother Lee has kept three basic principles that should rule and govern every believer in their interpretation, development, and expounding of the truths contained in the Scriptures. The first principle is that of the Triune God dispensing Himself into His chosen and redeemed people; the second principle is that we should interpret, develop, and expound the truths contained in the Bible with Christ for the church; and the third governing principle is Christ, the Spirit, life, and the church. No other study or exposition of the New Testament conveys the life nourishment or ushers the reader into the divine revelation of God's holy Word according to His New Testament economy as this one does.

The Collected Works of Witness Lee, 1967, volume 2 Living Stream Ministry

The *Collected Works of Witness Lee, 1963, volume 3*, contains the messages and fellowship given by Brother Witness Lee from July 13 through September 1, 1963, with the exception of messages he gave in a series on the Gospel of John, which are published in *Life-study of John* (not included in *The Collected Works*). The eight sections that constitute this volume are composed largely of messages that were given during the summer training held in Los Angeles and Altadena, California, from July 13 through August 22. The training covered four main areas: life, truth, the church, and service. The messages on life and on truth were given in the evening of each Monday, Tuesday, and Saturday, and the messages on the church and on service were given in the evening of each Thursday. The messages given in the evening focused on these four main areas, and the messages given in the morning were devoted to fellowship concerning personal problems, spiritual problems, the church, the local churches, the Lord's Day gathering, practical service, prayer, and Christian practices. The contents of this volume are as follows: 1. Eighteen messages concerning life given on July 13 through August 20 as part of the summer training. These messages have been published under the title *Basic Principles of the Experience of Life*. One message, chapter 9, is included also in *The Collected Works of Witness Lee, 1965, volume 3*, as chapter 8 of *Our Human Spirit*. 2. The five messages on truth given on July 13 through 22 as part of the summer training. Four of these messages have been published previously under the title *The Building of God*. However, in researching for *The Collected Works*, a fifth message was discovered. 3. Six messages on service given on July 18 through August 22 as part of the summer training. These messages have been published under the title *Basic Principles for the Service in the Church Life*. Chapters 1 through 3 are included also in *The Collected Works of Witness Lee, 1969, volume 1*, as chapters 6 through 8 of *To Serve in the Human Spirit*. 4. Six messages on the church given on July 18 through August 22 as part of the summer training. These messages have been published under the title *Basic Principles for the Practice of the Church Life*. 5. Messages 6 through 13 of the messages on truth given from July 23 through August 3 as part of the Summer Training. These messages have been published under the title *The Work of the Holy Spirit*. 6. Messages 14 through 18 of the messages on truth given from August 6 through 13 as part of the Summer Training. These messages have been published under the title *A Brief Definition of the Kingdom of the Heavens*. 7. Fourteen miscellaneous messages given in Los Angeles between July 16 and September 1. These messages are included in this volume under the title *Miscellaneous Messages*. 8. Miscellaneous fellowship given by Brother Lee to the saints in the Los Angeles area from July 19 through August 24. These messages are included in this volume under the title *Miscellaneous Speakings*. The contents of this section were composed from personal notes taken by brothers who were present in the meetings. Brother Lee gave four additional messages in Los Angeles during this period of time--on July 26 and August 9, 14, and 20--for which no record has been found.
